FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

I'm very excited to let you know that the Trinity Annual Conference has asked our church to host the "Revival on the Road" for the Lakes Area. These revivals are being held

in each Area of our Annual Conference. Here is what the conference is saying about them.

If you've been with us at any one of our Annual Conference gatherings, you've experienced it — an undeniable presence of the Holy Spirit filling the room and filling our hearts with passion to worship God and to share the love of Jesus Christ in a dark and hurting world. In these moments we capture glimpses of heaven, and we are left with a deep yearning for more as we seek to continually grow in our holiness of heart and life. These are moments too good not to share!

As we seek to build and advance our shared ministries in the Trinity Conference, we are also looking for ways to grow in holiness through a spirit of renewal and revival; not just once a year at Annual Conference but frequently through our area visits this fall and early spring.

We will be bringing revival on the road with powerful preaching, worship and prayer, so that members of our local churches can be encouraged and included in this movement of the Holy Spirit.

I am also excited to announce that Rev. Dr. Carolyn Moore will be our "Revival on the Road" preacher.

Rev. Dr. Carolyn Moore is an ordained elder in the Global Methodist Church and the founding pastor of Mosaic Church in Evans, Georgia, which she planted in 2003. A two-time graduate of Asbury Theological Seminary (M.Div. and D.Min.), she has been serving in pastoral ministry since 1998. Moore has been deeply involved with the Wesleyan Covenant Association, serving in leadership roles that include Chair and Vice-Chair, helping to shape the Global Methodist Church's formation.

In addition to her pastoral work, Carolyn is a prolific author, and she co-hosts the podcast The Art of Holiness, where she engages in conversations on supernatural ministry and practical holiness.

Many of you will know her as the author and teacher from our recent studies on the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit. Not only that, but Rev. Moore was also a key speaker at the recent Global Methodist Church's Convening General Conference. She delivered a sermon on the first day in Costa Rica, where she challenged the church to be attentive to the Holy Spirit with "flexible and moldable" hearts and minds. Her message resonated deeply as the church began this pivotal conference, focused on establishing foundational structures for our denomination's future.

I hope to see you at this wonderful event at **5:00 p.m., October 20**. Come, Holy Spirit, come!
